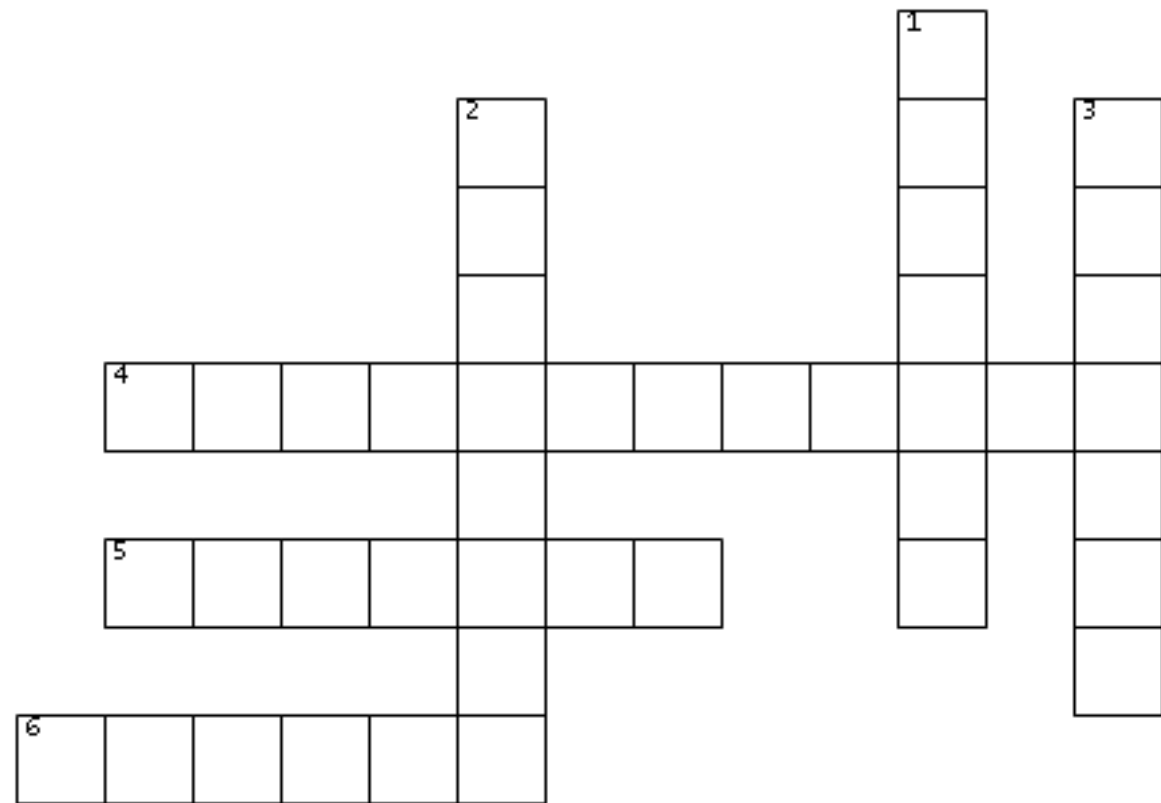

- _____ 10. Some popular cow breeds at fairs you might see include small, medium and large varieties.

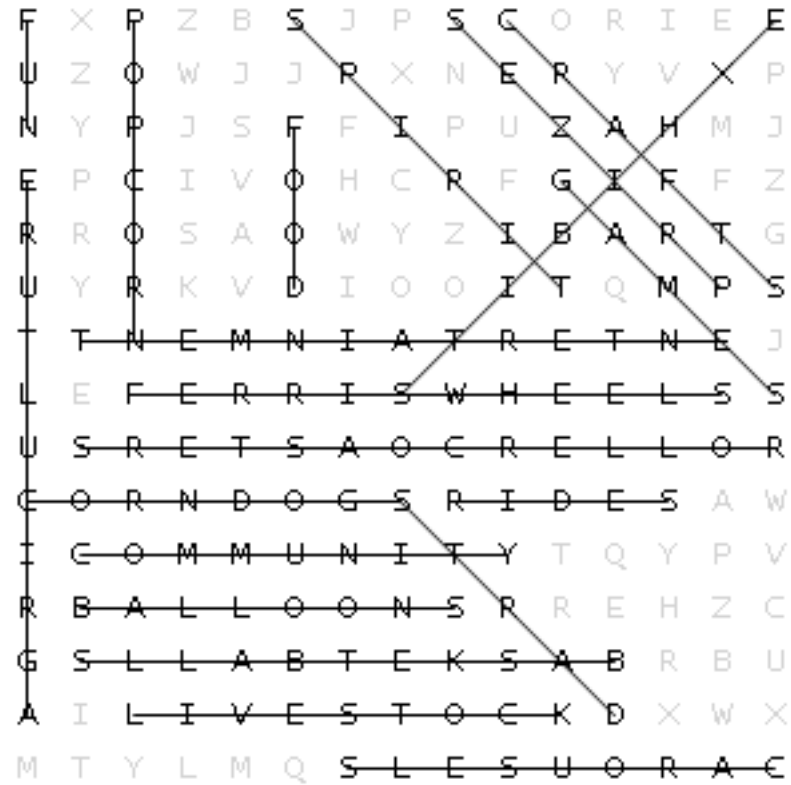

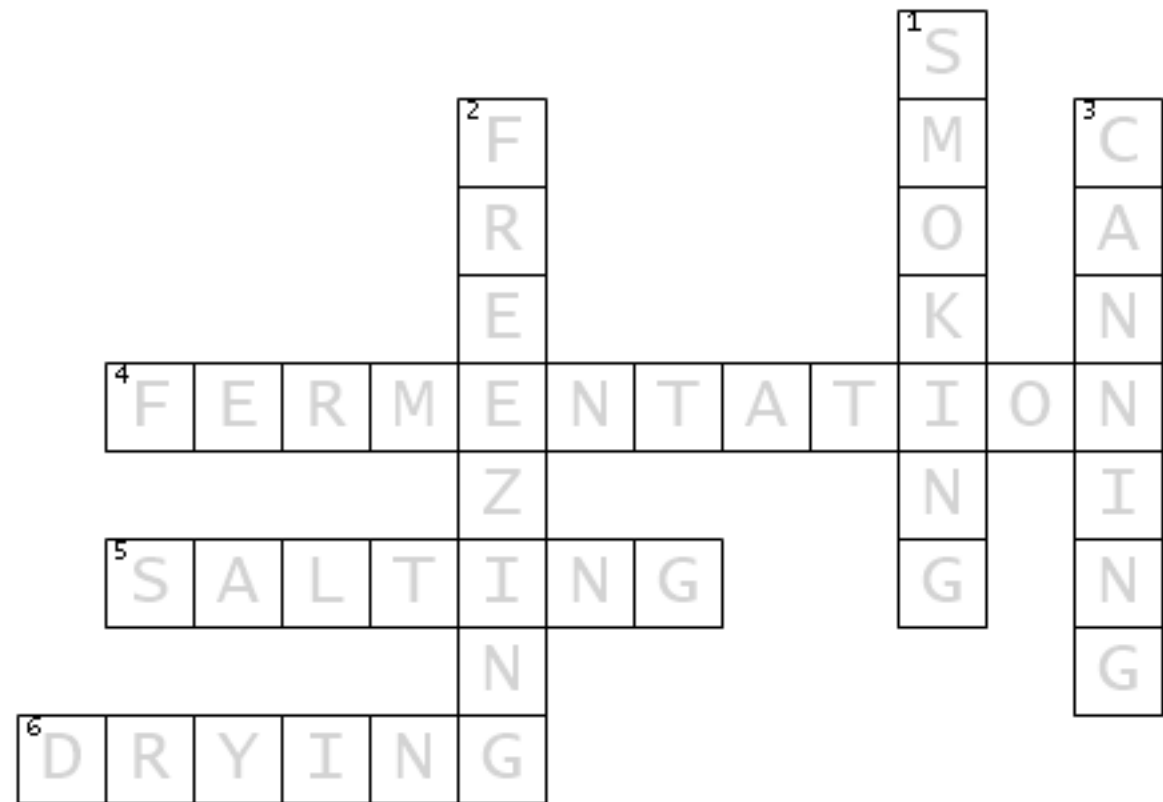


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
