Definitions

A frozen treat made by wrapping small scoops of ice cream in a sweet dough made from glutinous rice flour.

This dessert is made with cream, whipped cream, salep (flour made from orchid tubers), mastic (plant resin) and sugar. It has a hard texture, is resistant to melting and is stretchy like just-melted mozzarella.

A popular dessert made with shaved ice, swetened red beans, sweetcorn, evaporated milk, and various toppings, also known as ice beans.

Rolled ice cream or stir-fried ice cream, poured in a superchilled pan

This treat is thicker and richer in milk, as it typically uses more milk than cream in its recipe. It's name means "ice cream" in another language.

A type of ice cream made from condensed milk, sugar and flavors like saffron, rosewater or cardamom.

A dessert made made of whipped animal fat, such as caribou or moose, combined with meat, dried fish, and foraged summer berries, or mild sweeteners. <u>Terms</u>
