Students: After reading “Connections,” provide a description for the role of each bee named below in a hive. Name some of the functions and jobs for which each bee is responsible.

Parents and teachers: Answers are below but wording will vary.

1. The queen bee: This is the bee at the top of the entire hive. She lays eggs that will turn into the next generation of bees. This single bee controls the hive with chemicals called pheromones, which guide the behavior of the bees in the hive.

2. The worker bee: Female bees with the job of maintaining the hive by collecting pollen and nectar from flowers. These bees that build and defend the hive while also cleaning it and circulating the air inside it by flapping their wings.

3. The drone bee: These are the hundreds of these bees live inside the hive during the spring and summer seasons. They are male bees which help create future generations of bees.

4. Honey: This is the sweet food bees make. It is made through a chemical reaction involving bee saliva changing nectar into sugars.
