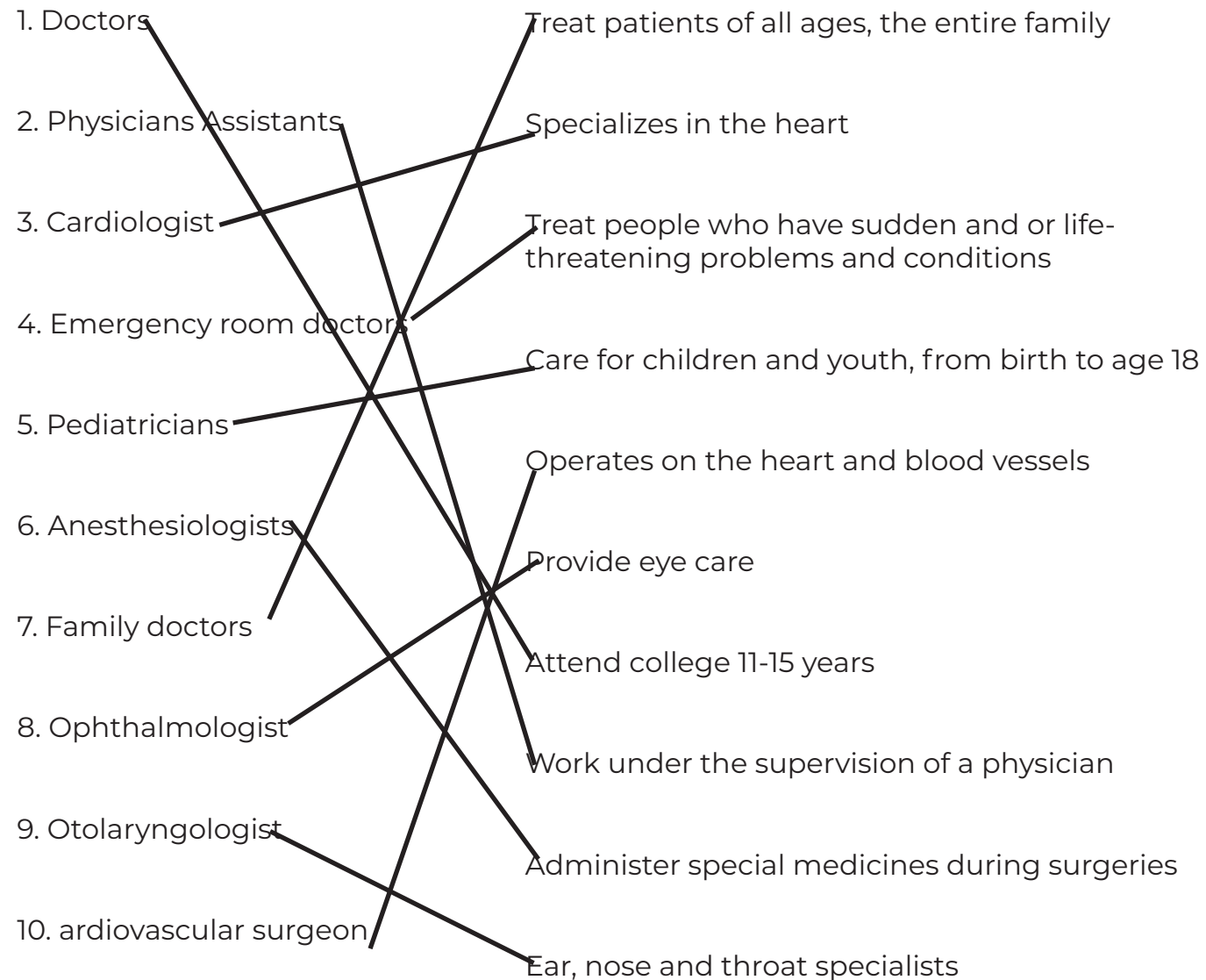

Students: After reading "Around the World," answer the questions below. Be sure to use complete sentences.

1. Name some of the early doctors and health care professionals who made a difference in medicine. How were they impactful?

Hippocrates of Greece, who lived around 460–370 BCEs known as the “father of modern medicine.” The Hippocratic Oath which new doctors take is named for him. From Scotland, William Hunter, 1718-1783, and his brother John Hunter work led to improvements in our understanding of anatomy. In 1796, Edward Jenner, a doctor from Berkeley, Gloucestershire, England, developed the smallpox vaccine. Louis Pasteur of France discovered that bacteria caused diseases; this was known as Germ Theory. Two 19th Century nurses, Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole, realized the importance of housing the sick in a clean environment while they recovered from their injuries.

2. What did you learn about how doctors and people used to practice medicine?
 Students should comment on how people used to believe evil spirits caused sickness and how they were uninformed on the relationship between cleanliness and disease.

3. What is the most amazing medical accomplishment you read about in this article?
 Answer will vary but most students will write about the smallpox vaccine.
